Thank you for your interest in the position of Support Worker at Thornage Hall. We currently have vacancies for full and part-time Support Workers as well as a full-time maternity cover post. Our full-time position works 37.5 hours a week on a shift rota system (early 7.30am – 3pm; late 2.30pm – 10pm). This includes working weekends.

We provide Supported Living and meaningful work activities for adults with learning difficulties within a community on a 70 acre biodynamic farm. We provide support through our Day Services where we provide training and meaningful work activities. Our ethos is to build on the strengths of individuals to enable them to learn new skills in traditional arts & crafts and biodynamic land management as well as learning basic skills required for the home and workplace.

As a Support Worker, you will be working in our houses providing person centred support to tenants helping them to reach their potential and live the life that they choose. We look for our staff to have a flexible and innovative approach to their work. Our Support Workers carry out a variety of tasks ranging from preparing breakfasts, personal care and support to trips to theatre or appointments.

We provide a comprehensive induction and training programme for all new staff to help you in learning your new role. This was recognised by CQC who commented that
